Our aim is to ensure that all reasonable and practical steps are taken to ensure the health, safety and welfare of all persons using the premises.

To achieve this we will actively work towards the following objectives:

To establish and maintain a safe and healthy environment throughout the studio building

To establish and maintain safe working procedures amongst Staff and Pupils

To formulate effective procedures for use in case of fire and other emergencies and for evacuating the premises

To maintain a safe and healthy place to work with safe access to and from the premises

To follow the regulations of the Health and Safety at Work Act 1974 and any other relevant legislation

To follow the rules of the studio buildings e.g. no smoking

No jewellery or body piercings may be worn during class

Dress code: uniform and appropriate shoes must be worn by all Pupils

No running on the premises

All fire exits are clearly marked and free from obstruction

All fire extinguishers are clearly labeled

Students will be fully supervised during class sessions

All equipment and resources are safe for Pupil use
